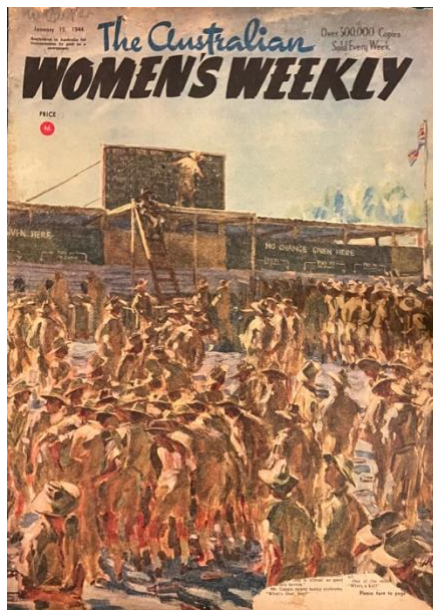

An Army Race Meeting, April 1943



The Australian Women's Weekly continued publication throughout the Second World War, selling a remarkable half a million copies an issue. Many of its articles had references to the progress of the war, contributing to civil morale. This January 1944 issue featured several paintings by WEP (Bill Pidgeon, 1908-1981) of a meeting of the 'North Australian Picnic Race Club' during his tour of northern operational areas – indeed, in the Northern Territory.

Horses were brought in from one of the stations and were auctioned to the troops. Buyer of the horse became the owner-trainer and had the right to select his own jockey. Proceeds of the horse sales were used as prize money for the race meeting.

The club was run entirely by Army personnel, officers and men, and jockey clubs on a grander scale might have been envious to hear that the total cost of the course was £15 for materials purchased. The rest was scrounged. The Allied Works Council lent graders and tractors, and the whole course was built in about three weeks. There was an elaborate tote, grandstand, judge's box, and all the facilities necessary for a racecourse. All the meetings benefited Red Cross funds or Prisoner of War Appeal funds. After the war the track was handed back to civilians in the area, complete with its picnic grounds.
