Propaganda Leaflets



This flimsy 2-sided leaflet in Vietnamese was dropped from the air on a Vietnamese village (Long Điền) for a First Australian Task Force (1 ATF) Cordon & Search operation in February 1968 called Operation Clayton.

The leaflet was prepared by the Psyops (psychological operations) detachment of the 1 ATF. The flamboyant figure, the 13th century Vietnamese hero

Prince Trần Hưng Đạo is shown exhorting the villagers to unify under the national flag to defeat the communists.

The sequence of events was to form a cordon around the village under the cover of darkness, drop the leaflets and search the village.

The search of over 5000 villagers found 30 Việt Cộng suspects and some South Vietnamese draft dodgers and deserters.
