26 January 1945: Borneo death march begins

26 January 1943: Brisbane-based US submarine Wahoo sank two Japanese transports off the coast of New Guinea

26 January 1943: Natives from Marchinbar Islands north of Arnhem Land rescue survivors from HMAS Patrick Cam helped by coastwatchers

27 January 1942: HMAS Vampire and HMS Thanet attacked the Japanese landing force at Endau, Malaya

28 January 1945: HMAS Melbourne (ex HMS Majestic) launched at Vickers Armstrong yard, England

29 January 1856: The VC instituted by Royal Warrant. First presentations were made on 26 June 1857 – one winner later dying in Melbourne

31 January 1945: Fremantle-based US submarine Boarfish sank Japanese transport Enki Maru off Indo China

2 February 1943: HMAS Manoora returned to service after conversion from armed merchant cruiser to a landing ship.

HMAS Sydney (III) – the Aircraft Carrier



We have recently been given an interesting collection of photos centred around HMAS Sydney.

HMAS Sydney (R17/A214/P214/L134) was the former HMS Terrible (1944), a Majestic-class light aircraft carrier, sold to

Australia in 1947 and completed, then commissioned into the RAN in 1948. She was the first RAN carrier, one of three operated during the cold war, and flagship until the 1960s.

Her career until 1973 included active service in the Korean War, use as a training vessel when HMAS Melbourne arrived in 1955, in reserve in 1958 but reactivated as fast troop transport from 1962, operating for Malaysia and from 1965, made one of 25 tours of duty in Vietnam until 1972 (nicknamed the Vung Tau Ferry).
