symbol, earlier than that mentioned last week. A particularly likely candidate is the logo of the Aldine Press in Venice - it first appeared in 1502. In 1507 Aldus told Erasmus that Bembo had given him a silver coin minted under the Roman Emperor Vespasian bearing an image of this device
