3 October 1950: 3 RAR suffers first Australian casualties of Korean War



The RAAF in 1938



This is the 48-page Souvenir Programme for an RAAF display in April 1938. It was staged in Sydney & Melbourne, with the Victorian venue being Flemington Racecourse.

87 aircraft took part in the demonstration. The types included were Moths, Avro Trainers, Wapitis Bulldogs, Seagull Vs, Demons, Gannets, Magisters, Wirraways (N.A. 16 & N.A. 33) and Avro Ansons. With perhaps the exception of the Ansons, none of these aircraft were really fit for service in the Second World War. Pilots included Sqn Ldr A.M. Charlesworth, AFC and Sqn Ldr F.R.W. Scherger.

The display was enthusiastically received by

the <u>public</u> and more than 200 enlistment enquiries were received. There is little doubt that this display demonstrated the parlous state of the equipment of the Air Force on the eve of conflict
