10 February 1964: The aircraft carrier HMAS Melbourne and the destroyer HMAS Voyager collided with the loss of 82 lives

11 February 1916: RAN Bridging Train assumed responsibility for the maintenance of bridges across the Suez Canal at Serapeum

12 February 1912: Commonwealth Naval Forces commenced building of a naval training depot at Hanns Island Vic, commissioned as Flinders Naval Depot in September 1920

14 February 1884: HMVS Victoria steam gunboat, Capt A.B. Thomas, RN, sailed from Portsmouth for Australia

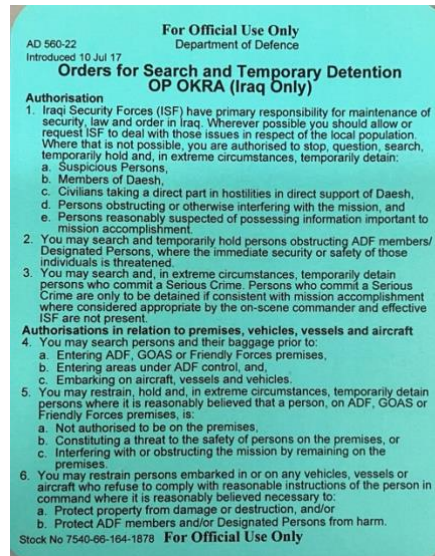
15 February 1942: Singapore surrendered to the Japanese

17 February 1803: Cdr Matthew Flinders, RN, HMS Investigator, found a fleet of 60 Malayan proas fishing in the Gulf of Carpentaria, of about 25 tons

Rules of Engagement Cards



Military Rules of Engagement (ROE) are directives that define when, where, and how forces may use force, balancing mission objectives with international law and civilian protection. These rules, which vary by nation and mission, cover targeting, self-defence and non-combatant treatment. ROE are essential for compliance with principles like proportionality and distinction, are often classified and typically issued to soldiers as pocket cards.

The card illustrated was issued to Australian defence personnel in 2017 for Operation OKRA in Iraq. This operation, established in 2014, was Australia's commitment to the US-led multinational Combined Joint Task Force - Operation Inherent Resolve, formed to secure a lasting defeat of the violent extremist group Daesh.

The card covers procedures for search and temporary detention. These personnel were required to understand and comply with the complex conditions outlined on the card. There was also a companion card - Orders for Opening Fire.
