## Navy Week 1949

The first post-war Navy Week began in Melbourne on 20 October 1949. Ten Australian and New Zealand warships arrived at Port Melbourne and remained there for a fortnight. The celebrations provided opportunities for the public to see the ships and to arouse interest in the appeal for funds for a second memorial chapel at the Flinders Naval Depot (now HMAS Cerberus), to commemorate officers and men of the Royal Australian Navy who lost their lives in the first and second world wars.

The vessels were the newly designated flagship, the aircraft carrier HMAS *Sydney*, together with the cruiser HMAS *Australia*, destroyer *Warramunga* and frigate *Shoalhaven* with the cruiser HMNZS *Bellona* and frigates HMNZS *Taupo*, *Kaniere*, *Tutira*, *Rotoiti* and *Pukaki*.

The RAN had mobilised from a pre-war strength of 5440 to a wartime 37,200 plus 2700 WRANS. In 1949 it was 12,000 strong: its strength now is over 16,000.
