

A First World War Pay Book

This is the soldier's pay book of 3598 Private Thomas Dickson Rait, 24th Battalion AIF.

Rait was born in Beeac Victoria, and worked as a station hand. He enlisted in May 1915 after having previously been rejected as too short. (He was 5'2".) He was assigned to the 24th Battalion, leaving Australia in January 1916 for service on the Western Front. His service was interrupted by bouts of gastritis for which he was hospitalised. He was posted to HQ of the 2nd Infantry Brigade He returned to Australia in July 1917 because of his stomach ulcers caused by tuberculosis.



After the war he sought a War Service Loan to purchase a house. His war service is commemorated in Colac – and then he sadly disappears from view.
