Forthcoming Anniversaries

17 February 1803: Cdr Matthew Flinders, RN, HMS Investigator, found a fleet of 60 Malayan proas fishing in the Gulf of Carpentaria, of about 25 tons

18 February 1865: The Confederate raider *Shenandoah* sailed from Port Phillip and later raided the American whaling fleet in the North Atlantic

18 February 1942: The carriers Akagi, Kaga, Hiryu and Soryu with 5 heavy cruisers and 20 destroyers entered the Banda Sea to launch the air attack on Darwin

19 February 1942: Japanese aircraft attacked Darwin

21 February 1945: HMAS Napier bombarded Japanese positions on the Burma coast

23 February 1861: A 76-man-strong naval brigade from HMS Fawn was despatched from Sydney with a military contingent to put down lawlessness among miners at Lambing Flat



24 February 1941: The cruisers HMAS Perth and HMS Bonaventure landed a Commando force on Castellorizo in the Dodecanese coinciding with the landing of a stronger enemy force
