

12 October 1943: RAAF Beaufighters attack Japanese positions at Rabaul 13 October 1944: Australian naval squadron departs Hollandia for Leyte 15 October 1918: Lt George 'Morby' Ingram, 24 Bn, awarded the VC for his actions at Montbrehain, France 18 October 1943: Strong attack by Japanese 20 Bde on Australian 9 Div at Scarlet Beach, New Guinea 18 October 1944: HMAS Geelong sinks off New Guinea **18 October 1950:** – 3 RAR, with American tanks in support, captures Samgapo, Korea 20 October 1942: 16 Bde attacks Japanese positions at Eora Creek **20 October 1944:** RAN supports US landings on Leyte, Philippines.



The Royal Australian Army Nursing Service (RAANS) was the predecessor to the Royal Australian Army Nursing Corps (RAANC). Established as the Australian Army Nursing Service (AANS) in 1902, it served as a volunteer of nurses for emergencies and was a key part of Australia's military nursing during both World Wars. The "Royal" title was granted to the service in 1948 for its contributions, and in 1949, it was incorporated into the Australian Regular Army, leading to the

formation of the RAANC in 1951.

To complicate the acronym soup, RAANS incorporated the Australian Army Medical Women's Service (AAMWS).
