## Forthcoming Anniversaries

**3 February 1942:** Japanese bombers launched first heavy air attack on Port Moresby

**4 February 1945:** The Fremantle-based US submarine Barbel sunk by Japanese aircraft off Palawa - no survivors  
**6 February 1967:** The first RAN unit to serve in Việt Nam, Clearance Diving Team 3, arrives

**8 February 1948:** HMAS

Wyatt Earp sailed from Melbourne for Antarctica

**9 February 1919:** HMS Vendetta, later HMAS Vendetta, engaged Bolshevik ground troops with gunfire at Windau on the Baltic to relieve pressure on the Lettish Army

**10 February 1964:** The aircraft carrier HMAS Melbourne and the destroyer HMAS Voyager collided with the loss of 82 lives





## Naval Boarding Operations - Iraq

This is a recent addition to our collection – a double-sided leaflet (in English & Arabic) to be issued to boarded vessels to ensure that they were not carrying contraband or fleeing members of the Saddam Hussein regime.

The leaflet was aboard HMAS *Kanimbla* that deployed to the North Arabian Gulf in February 2003. RAN Clearance Diving teams cleared mines from the Khawr abd Allah, a narrow stretch of water leading to the port at Umm Qasr. Australia was responsible for keeping this port open, and for seizing and securing Iraqi offshore oil platforms.

The Australian vessel (with boarding teams from US, UK and Australia) was used to monitor and board the smaller craft trying to leave the waters outside Umm Qasr. This helped free up larger Coalition warships.
