World War Two & the Old Melbourne Gaol



War Diary for 4 Australian Guard Compound August 1943 - AWM

At the beginning of 1942 the Australian Defence Department commandeered Old Melbourne Gaol for the temporary incarceration of military prisoners from the three armed services. The servicemen would have committed military offences such as drunkeness or absence without leave and had been sententenced to periods of imprisonment inder military law.

The Gaol was re-named as the

4th Australian Guard Compound and staffed by Army. In August 1943 there was an average of around 110 prisoners under arrest or serving sentences with a prison staff of 40 under command of Lt Victor Charles Murphy, a First World War veteran.

For a short time this unit also held the recaptured group of German prisoners of war led by Kapitän zur See Theodor Detmers of the *Komoran*, the vessel that sank HMAS *Sydney*. This group had escaped from their prison at Murchison on 11th January 1945 by tunnels. On recapture they were sentened to 28 days detention for escaping. Detmers complained about the prison conditions, the food and being kept with NCOs.

During the Second World War there were also other Detention Barracks in Victoria including the 2nd (Puckapunyal), 7th (Bendigo), 8th (Geelong) and 10th (Portsea).
