Birthday RUSIV!


- **2 June 1967:** 2 RAR arrives in Viêt Nam

- 8 June 1941: 7 Div and British forces attack Vichy French during the allied Syrian campaign
- 9 *June* 1941: 7 Div cross Litani River, Lebanon

The Other Side of the Hill - Jutland

The naval battle of Jutland took place with three main engagements from 31 May to 1 June 1916, off the North Sea coast of Denmark's Jutland Peninsula. It was the largest naval battle and only full-scale clash of battleships of the First World War. The outcome ensured that the Royal Navy denied the German surface fleet access to the North Sea and the Atlantic for the remainder of the war. Germany avoided all fleet-to-fleet contact thereafter. Jutland was also the last major naval battle, in any war, fought primarily by battleships.



The battle is known as the Battle of the Skagerrak in German and this 1935 account is one of several in our library in German.
